The Board of Fire Commissioners of the North Aurora Fire Protection District, Kane County IL is seeking applicants to establish an eligibility list from which vacancies will be filled for Full-Time Firefighter/ EMT-B.

FIREFIGHTER MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- **Minimum of High School Diploma or G.E.D.**
- **Must be 21 years of age and under 35** as of the date submission of application, except as otherwise provided by state statute (70 ILCS 605/16.06b; 65 ILCS 5/10-2. 1-6)
- **Illinois Department of Public Health, EMT – B certification** by time of initial hire and be a certified IDPH, EMT -P within 18 months of initial hire date.
- **Illinois State Fire Marshal Firefighter II or Basic Operations Firefighter Certification**
- **No Felony Convictions**
- **Applicants must be citizens of the United States** or an alien admitted for permanent residence or lawfully admitted for temporary residence who produces evidence of intention to become a United States Citizen. Applicants selected for employment must meet the District's residency requirement within 1 year of hire. Interstate 90 to the north, Route 23 to the west, Interstate 80 to the south and Interstate 355 to the east.
- **Valid Driver's License**
- **Current valid Candidate Physical Ability Test (CPAT) with ladder climb certification**, issued by a licensed agency * (see below) within 12 months prior to the written test date (1/6/16). The cost to be borne by the candidate. Cards will be accepted up to the time of the written exam.
- **Application Packets** must be picked up in person beginning November 2nd, 2015 at the North Aurora Fire Protection District Headquarters Station 1, 2 N. Monroe St., North Aurora IL 60542 between the hours of 8:30 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. A photo ID and a \$25.00 test fee will be required when the packet is picked up.
- **Completed Applications** must be returned in person no later than 4:00 p.m. on November 13th, 2015.
- **Attend a mandatory orientation** to be held on January 6th, 2016 at 7:00 p.m., at North Aurora Fire Protection District Headquarters, Station 1, 2 N. Monroe St., North Aurora IL 60542. No late admittances after 7:00 p.m.
- **Must be able to pass a written exam** consisting of 30% understanding written information, 30% mathematical ability, 25% mechanical ability, and 15% teamwork, public relations, and community living. The written exam is weighted at 65%. The minimum passing score to continue in the process is 70%. The written exam will be held on January 16th, 2016, 8:00a.m. at the North Aurora Police Station community room, 200 S. Lincolnway, North Aurora IL 60542
- **Participate in a Fire Commission Oral Interview** consisting of ten oral questions provided the candidate passes the written exam. The oral interviews will take place immediately following the written exam at the same location. Candidates will be advised of their sequence for the oral interview. The Fire Commission oral interview is weighted at 35%.
