

North Aurora Fire Department Premise Alert Program Notification

During the Summer 2009 session of the Illinois Legislature, the Illinois Premise Alert Act (ILPAA) PA96-0788) was passed which requires Public Safety agencies with Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) programs to initiate a Premise Alert Program (PAP) to maintain information on individuals with special needs within their coverage area. This act was signed by Governor Quinn on August 28, 2009.

The Illinois Premise Alert Program (Public Act 96-0788) provides for Public Safety agencies in the State of Illinois to allow people with special needs to provide information to Fire, Emergency Medical Services (EMS), and Police personnel to be kept in a database. The information can then be provided to responders dealing with situations involving special needs individuals.

Public Safety agencies are required to publicize and accept notifications from the individuals, their families, or caregivers. Agencies are then required to be able to identify and be aware of these situations when responding to calls or coming across individuals.

Residences of the Village of North Aurora and the North Aurora Fire Protection District can contact the North Aurora Fire Department at 630-897-9698 for a "Premise Alert Program Notification Form" or print one from our website. Once the form has been completed, it must be returned to either North Aurora Fire Station (2 N. Monroe Street or 2201 Tanner Road). The Special Needs information expires two (2) years after the data is submitted.

The data is provided by the individual or other person in order to provide responding Police, Fire, or EMS personnel with information to provide emergency services. The information will be entered into databases maintained by the Police and Fire Departments, and may be shared with other police, fire or EMS agencies as needed to provide services to the individual.

The individual(s) must understand that the information provided here will not result in any type of preferential treatment to the individual(s) and that the Village of North Aurora, its police and fire departments or any other responding agencies will not be held liable for duties relating to the reporting of special needs individuals.

I also understand that, if any of the above information changes, I must notify the North Aurora Fire Protection District by filing an amended request form. The information will self expire two (2) years from the date received by the Fire Department, and I must renew the form if I want the information kept in the Police and Fire Databases.
